2	Have I completed the GACE Educator Ethics Entry Assessment (#350)?	
3	Do I have at least 60 credit hours that fulfill Core requirements and a GPA of at least 2.8? See list of courses above. <i>Note: if you have an Associate's from a USG institution, your core is complete!</i>	

How to Apply

If you checked off both questions above, you are *ready to apply to the Special Education Online Program*. We will provide a preliminary review and let you know which semester you should apply to UGA.

1	Complete the Special Education Online Program Readiness Check.	
2	Gather your unofficial transcripts from each school you have attended and submit to the <u>Special Education Online Program Transcript Upload Form</u> .	

The Special Education Online Program admits once annually in Fall (August). Get started on your application early to meet upcoming deadlines!
